



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the second day of Septem^r 1734 Surveyed unto Mary Leacock a tract of Land situate in Newcowissihoppin in the County of Philad^a. Begining at a post a corner of a tract of Land laid out to Christopher Smith thence by the same North West one hundred and Seventy perches and by vacant land of same course twenty three perches to a post thence by Vacant land North East one hundred and ten perches to a post thence by Vacant land South East one hundred and Ninety three perches to a Chesnut tree thence thence by Vacant Land South West one hundred and ten perches to a place of Begining, Containing one hundred & twenty five acres of Land with a usual allowance of six P.
