



Situate in Wheatfield Township (formerly Aye-) Perry County. Contain-
 ing Three hundred and twenty three acres One hundred and two perches & allowance
 of six per Cent for roads &c. Resurveyed the 6th day of May 1828 agreeable to a Survey
 made for John Lawshe (by virtue of his Improvement) the 17th January 1797 which appears
 by a draught remaining on file in the Deputy Surveyors Office of Perry County except 5²⁵
 137 P^e at the N.E. Corner Marked thus (E) which was excluded by the first Survey and
 afterwards Included by Probt. Olack Esqr when executing the warrant of Isaac Kirkpatrick
 in the year 1813 or 1814. Resurveyed as above In pursuance of said warrant granted
 Isaac Kirkpatrick the 15th day of November A.D. 1813 for 400²⁵
