Situate in Franklin Township York County and surveyed the 9th Day of March 1793 for John Kerbach in pursuance of a Warrant for 120^a granted to George Kerns dated 25th February 1790 -

N.B. The Warrant Right aforesaid was sold by said George Kerns to James McCoss & which land as the property of McCoss was taken in Execution and sold by the Sheriff for his Debt - purchased by Wampler & sold by him to John Kerbach the present owner - after which sales the Warrant was put into my hands by James McCoss who till then had it in his possession - I have been thus particular as the Warrant is neither mentioned in the Sheriffs Deed nor from Wampler to Kerbach -
