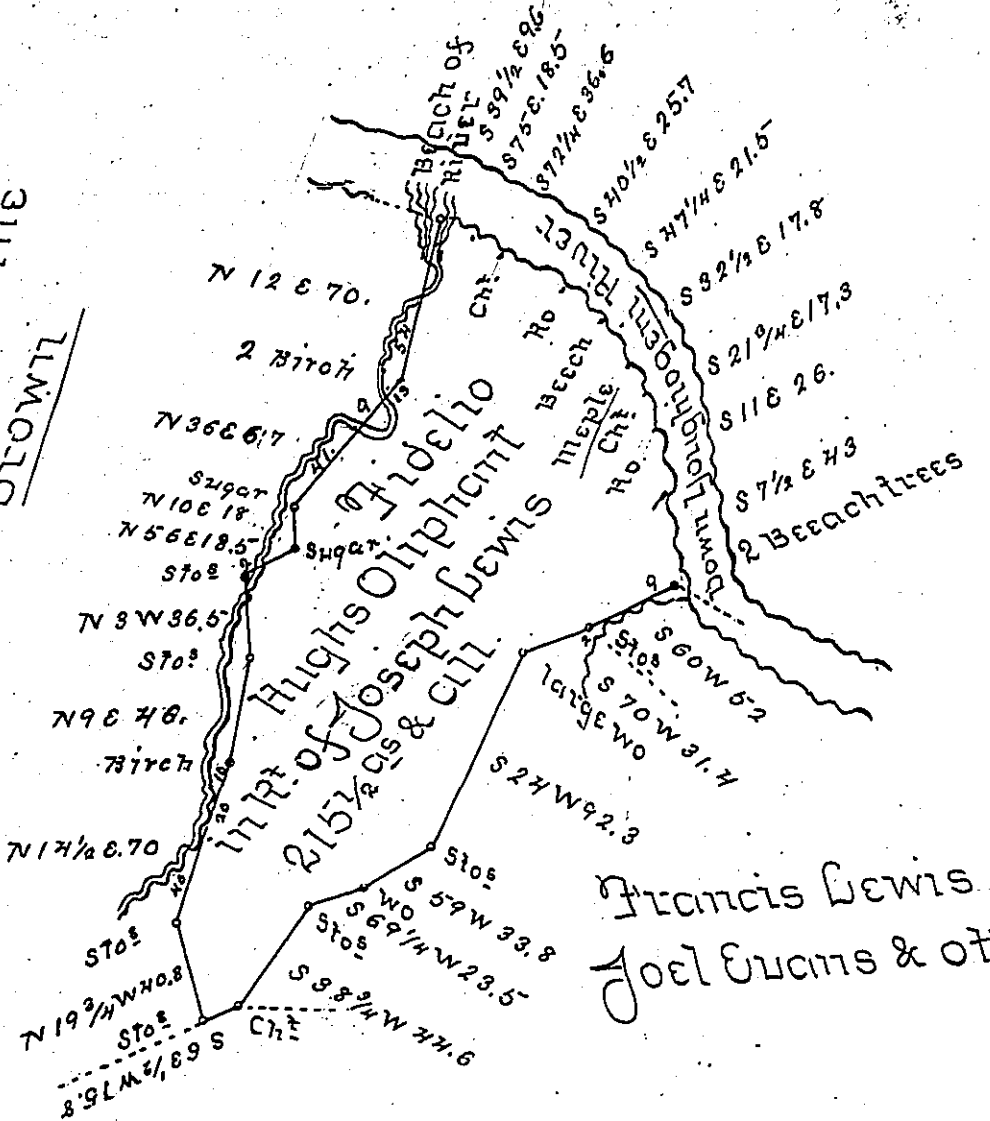


Chas March Westerly of Brown

geni River in Franklin Township Fayette County and  
Surveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April 1831 In pursuance of a  
Warrant in the name of Joseph Lewis for 200 acres  
dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of September 1805 ---

There is 12 or 15 acres cleared on this tract an old log  
house or Cabin in which a family resides a few  
apple trees and a saw mill at the mouth of the Run  
it is upward of 20 years since the first improve-  
ment was made.
