



"Situate on the path that leads from Dunbars Camp to the Saltworks and on the waters of Dunbars Run in Wharton Township Fayette County &c" this was surveyed 15th June 1795 on a Warrant dated 12th March 1794 & Recorded in Survey Book 5 Page 155 1st C. L. E. 17th C. L. E. Clean then U.S. But the Survey being erroneous (called 395^{as}) we have corrected it by a private Survey lately made for ascertaining the lines & and find it to contain 417 1/2^{as} & all several of the lines as recorded being materially different from the marks on the ground
