Begins at a Burch tree on Susquehanna River & thence by Vacant Land N 36° W 52 perches to a post &c<sup>a</sup> Situate on Susquehanna-River nearly opposite to the Bear Islands in Drummors Township Lancaster County. Scale 40<sup>th</sup> to an Inch 31<sup>st</sup> 5 mo. 1758.
