



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 10th of February 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Jonathan Leet. for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4th of January 1794 Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the Waters of Big Beaver Creek Adjoining Land Granted to Daniel Leet.

Called Cole Hill Containing four Hundred Acres and Allowance of Six p^{ct} Cent for Roads.
