



Situate on the west side of Sidleing-Hill on both sides of Shelveys road, in Bethel township and County of Bedford including an improvement containing three hundred acres and thirty two perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Survey'd for John Hunter the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 1804 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of Feb'y 1802.
