



Thos Cunningham's claim

In pursuance of a warrant dated the first day of July 1784 was Survey'd for Edward Lynch the above described tract of land containing Three hundred and seventy five acres and Ninety seven perches with an allowance proportioned to six p cent Situate on the waters of Plumb Creek joining land of Hugh Davison and others in Pitt township Westmoreland County. Survey'd December 10<sup>th</sup> 1785.
