



A draught of (ob)key made February 7th 1821 in pursuance of a Wart granted Noah Hobbs bearing date 7th of October 1819 containing 141 As. & 80 ps. and allowance of six per cent for roads situate in Whiteley township in the County of Greene called "Contest"

To Jacob Spangler Esq^r S.G. John Fordyce D.S.

The above survey appears to have been settled about 23 years and it is said that it was surveyed on Wart in 1794. I could not find any marked lines nor do not know the warrantees name if any such there be. John Fordyce
