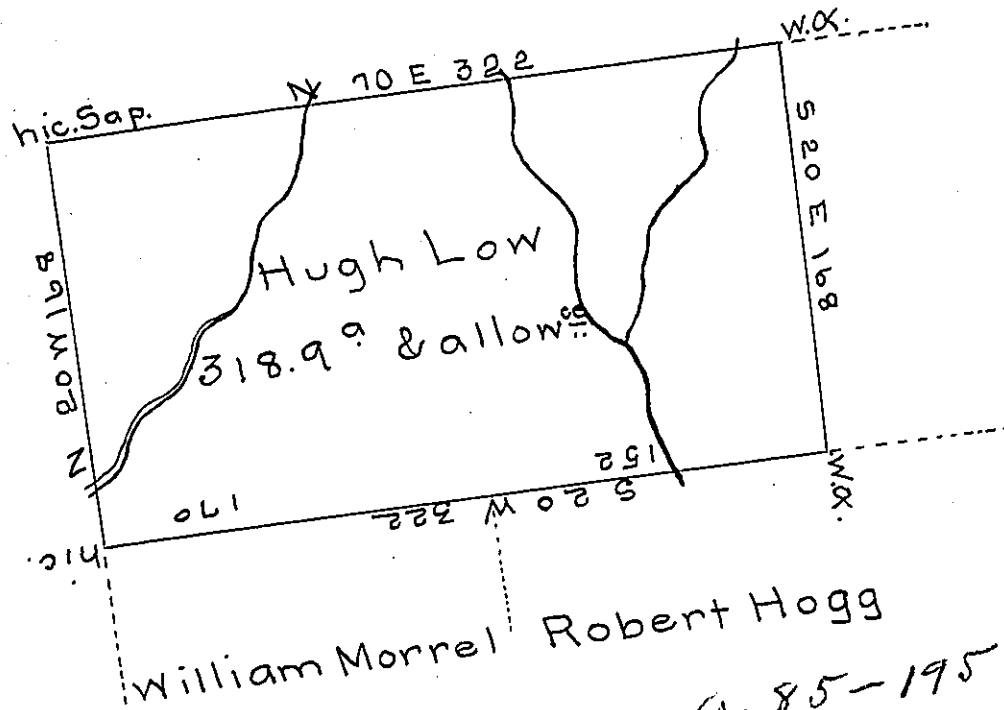

The Rich Land Survey'd to Hugh Low on the 10th. day of November 1773. Containing three hundred eighteen acres & three quarters of an acre & the usual allowance of six ~~ro~~^{ro}. Situate on the waters of Black Lick creek between the heads of the West Branch of Susquehanna—& the two Lick Creek adjoining William Morrel in Westmoreland County By warrant of the 4th. Day of August 1773.
