



By virtue of a warrant dated the 13 December 1792 N° 3025 there was surveyed the 15th August 1794 by W^m P. Brady the former Deputy Surveyor to Herman Le Roy and Jan Linklean the above described tract of nine hundred & fourteen acres & twenty five perches & allowance situate on the waters of Stump Creek in the late purchase, District N° 5 in the County of Lycoming - A copy of which remains in my office.
