



Situate in Fawn township in the County of York containing as above set forth 133 ⁹/₁₀ perches and allowance being part of a larger tract of land of 192 ¹/₄ ⁹/₁₀ which was originally surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 23rd day of the 8th month 1787 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Livingston bearing date the 2nd day of February 1787 and now on the 20th day of October Anno Domini 1813 Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land at the request of John Livingston the present owner who desired the same to be returned for confirmation -
