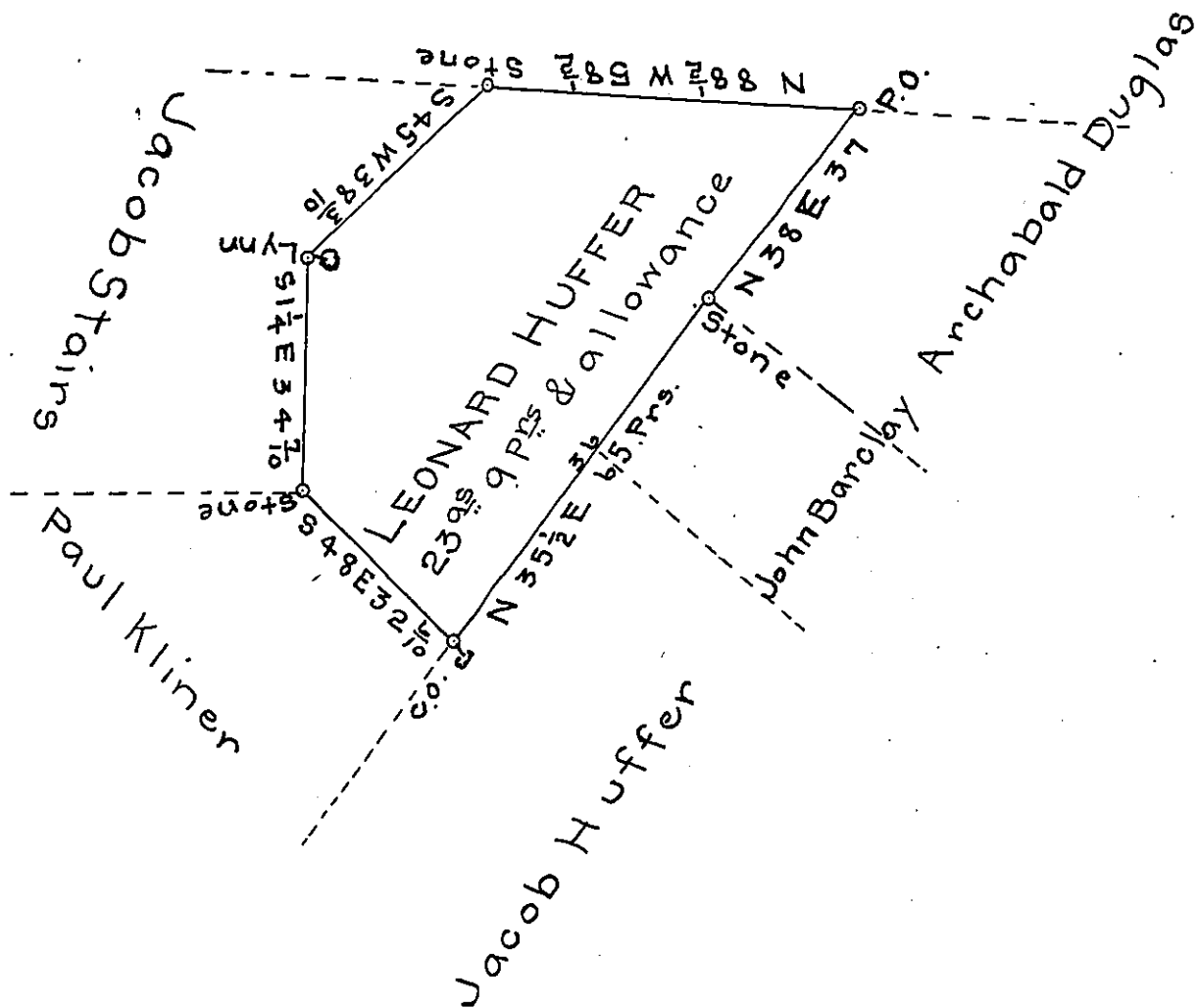


John Harmon's Land



May 9<sup>th</sup> 1861.

Surveyed the above described tract of land in pursuance of a warrant granted to Leonard Huffer bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 1861. Situate in Donegal township Westmoreland County Penn<sup>a</sup> Containing twenty three acres and nine perches and the usual allowance of six per cent &c.
