



Situate in Windsor township in the County of York, Containing within the black lines as above set forth 12^{as} 48 perches and the usual allowance & c^a. Being part of a larger tract of land Originally Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant for 100^{as} Granted to Andrew Fiester, dated the 10th day of June 1762. Resurveyed and laid off from said larger tract of land the 13th day of June 1821 and now this 19th day of February A.D. 1827 the same has been calculated, examined, found correct and returned for confirmation.
