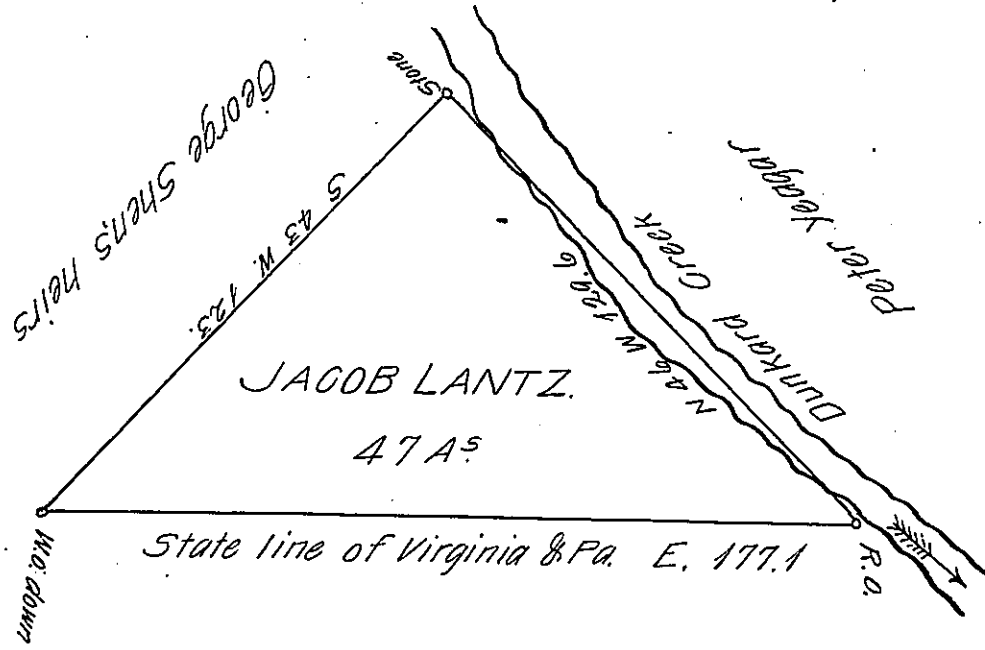


near to lands of Jacob Lantz & Jo^s Reed Esq^r

The Warr^t issued in the name of Jacob Lantz Call^g for land in Whitely Township it is probable that this was an error in the application I drew the Application in haste read it to Mr Lantz and was present when it was Executed but as Wayne & Whitely Townships Adjoin each other and were formerly one Township the error might have escaped our notice Jacob Lantz lives in Wayne Township this survey Joins his other lands nearly and at the time the application was written it was believed that the vacant land did extend to his other lands.
