



A Draught of a Survey made by John Churchman about the Year 1737 for Martin Adams In Pursuance of a Warrant bearing Date the 25<sup>th</sup> of May 1737, Several of the Lines having been since again Proved & remeasured & a small Stripe of Vacancy added, the first Survey not being the Compliment of the Warrant. It now Contains 215<sup>9</sup> and allowance of 6<sup>9</sup> per Cent for Roads &c. Situate in Oxford (formerly London Dery) Township on the Branches of Octorao Resurvey'd (in part) the 30<sup>th</sup> of the 4<sup>th</sup> mo. 1755. & Certify'd
