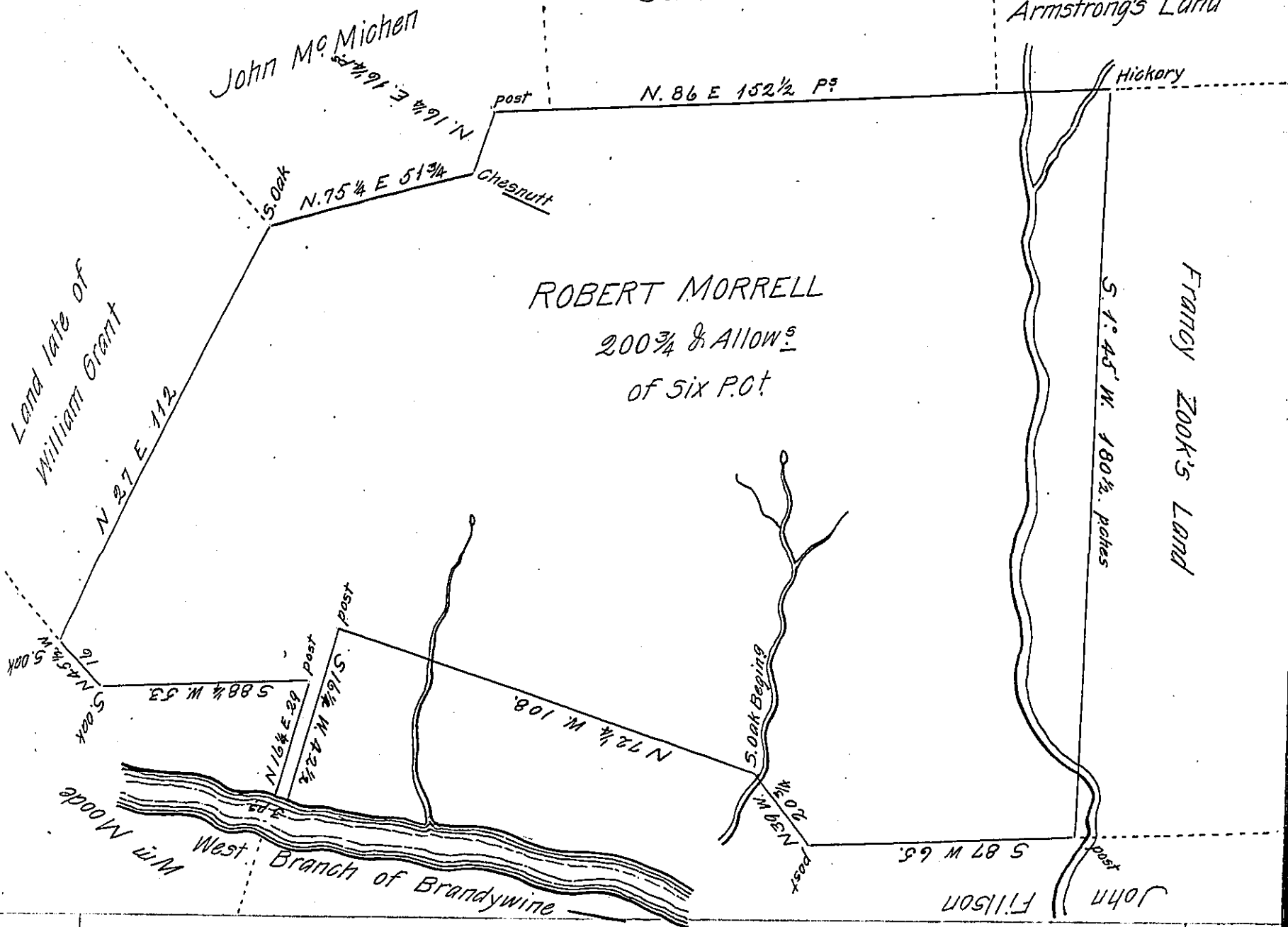

By Virtue of a Warrant granted to Robert Morrell for 180 Acres of Land bearing date the 21st Decem^r last, to me Directed, have Surveyed unto the Said Rob^t Morrell the above Described Tract of Land, Beginning at a Spanish Oak in the line of Land of John Fillson thence N 72 1/4 W 108 p^s to a post, S 16 1/4 W 42 p^s to Brandywine Creek, thence to a post up the Same N 71 W 3 P^s thence N 16 1/4 E 29 p^s in the line of William Moodes Land, thence S 88 1/4 W 53 to a Spanish Oak, N 45 1/2 W 16, to a Spanish Oak, thence by Land late Wm Grants N 27 E 112 to a Spanish Oak thence by Land of Jn^o Micken N 75 1/4 E 51 3/4 to a Chestnut N 16 1/4 E 16 1/4 to a post, thence by Said land, Land of John Elliott & Land late of Samuel Armstrong (deceas'd.) N 86 E 152 1/2 to a Hickory thence by Land of Francis Lookes N 1 1/4 W 180 1/2 to a post thence by P. Fillson's Land S 87 W 65 to a post and N 37 W 20 3/4 p^s to the place of Beginning Contain^g 200 3/4 Ac^s & Allow^{ce} for Roads & c Situate in East Fallowfield Township Chester County, Surveyed January 14th 1785.
