That part of the above described Tract marked ^B and separated from the rest of the Tract by the red line, has been included in a Survey (represented by the red drawn lines) made the 17 April 1772 On an Order of Survey to John Lindsay Senr dated 2 April 1767 No 3302, which Survey has been Returned containing 327 1/2 156 & said to be patented.

N.B. The part under the Location right interfering with the part under the Warrant right contains 110 Acres 75 ps of allowance, leaving 82 Acres 143 ps & al. Clear of interference.

Owned & occupied by the heirs of John Lindsay Junr decd the widow in possession - except a small part sold off to Michael Reed.
