



Situate in Antis Township Huntingdon County Containing three hundred & thirty one acres one hundred & thirty perches and the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. first Surveyed the 8th day of August 1802 in pursuance of an Order No 1579 & dated the 18th of October 1766 Granted to Hugh Tomb. It was then said to contain Eight hundred & ninety acres one hundred forty seven perches &c. The piece included in the dotted lines & marked C Contains one acre one hundred thirty perches &c. and is claimed by John Henshey by virtue of an Improvement & Warrant Dated 11th of June 1836, Resurveyed the 15th of February 1837 in pursuance of an Order granted by the Board of Property the 30th day of January A.D. 1837.
