 the above with other land the Residue of James Murrays  
 Warrant was Surveyed to James Murray the 2<sup>d</sup> of November  
 1785 by the then Deputy and since surveyed agreeably to the  
 old lines on the 5<sup>th</sup> of October 1803 as appears by the re-  
 turn herewith transmitted and at the request of the pres-  
 ent Claimant Charles Cochran the above Tract of fifty  
 three acres & 9 perches of land & all<sup>s</sup> has been divided  
 off said Tract situated as above that it may be return-  
 ed into your office is Certifi'd this 10<sup>th</sup> day of Novem-  
 ber 1803
