



In pursuance of a Warrant of 46 acres & 64 perches granted to Samuel B. Long of Meadville, of County of Crawford dated the 25th day of November A.D. 1848 was surveyed the 1st day of March 1849 the annexed described tract of land containing 46^{ac} & 64^{ps} and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situate in Sadsbury Township, Crawford County and Bounded as follows, on the North by land surveyed in the name of John Brooks now Jacob Shontz, on the East by land of Esack Fitz Randolph on warrant dated Dec 1st 1801 & patented to U. Montgomery; on the South by land now claimed by Mushrush and on the West by land surveyed for Thomas Wilson now Robert Andrews and Radure.
