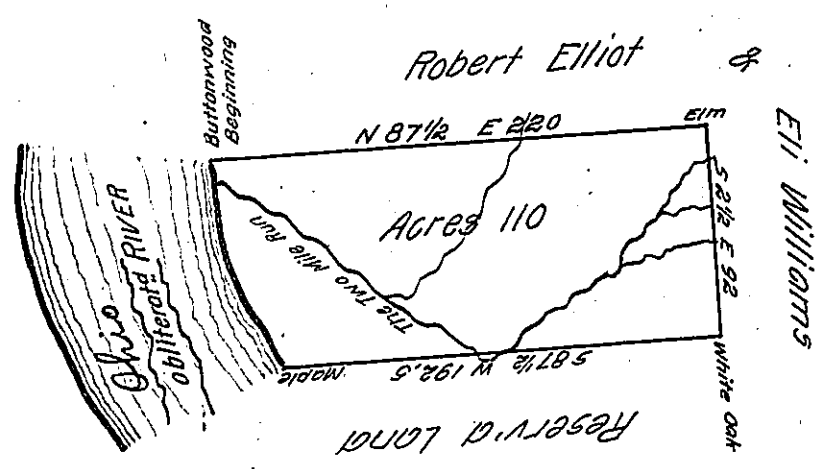

The above is a draught of a survey made May the 15th 1792 for Robert Elliot and Eli Williams Assignees of Jonathan Leet and in pursuance of a warrant granted to said Jonathan Leet for 100 acres of land dated the eleventh day of Aprile in the year 1792 situate on the north and west of the rivers Ohio Alleghany and Conawango Creek joining the lower side of the reserved land opposite Pittsburgh nearely opposite the lower part of Hamilton Island containing one hundred and ten ^{3/4} } with the usual allowance of six per cent
for roads called the Walnut ^{flat} } lot
