



The draught of a tract of land situate in Dickason Township  
 Cumberland County Containing four hundred & forty acres and one  
 hundred and twenty four perches & allowance of six P. cent for  
 roads &c. which appears to have been survey<sup>d</sup> the 16<sup>th</sup> day of  
 January 1795 in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Levis  
 dated February 24<sup>th</sup> 1794 the original of which has been delivered  
 over to me by my predecessor Sam<sup>l</sup>. Lyon Esq<sup>r</sup>. as an office paper  
 the survey must have been executed under the direction of Sam<sup>l</sup>.  
 Lyon Esq<sup>r</sup>. who was the Deputy Surveyor of the district at the date of  
 the survey
