



The above draft describes a piece of land situate in Washington Township in the County of Franklin containing sixteen acres 26 perches & the allowance of six P cent for roads &c survey'd 2<sup>d</sup> May 1800 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Christian Gilbert bearing date 30<sup>th</sup> May 1791. Gall Dan! Hughes owner of the lands on the north & south sides of this survey alleges said lands should bound on each other but by running the lines of the two surveys (which are held on Maryland rights & the lines not marked) the above described piece of land is found to lye between them.
