



Whereas William Latta in pursuance of a warrant dated Feb'y. 4th 1786 obtained a survey in South Huntingdon Township in the County of Westmoreland and whereas the said William Latta convey'd a part thereof to his son Moses Latta therefore at the request of the said William Latta & Moses Latta I have survey'd the above described piece of land to the said Moses Latta containing fifty three acres and 148 perches with an allowance proportioned to six P cent it being a part of the survey first above mentioned survey'd Jan'y. 18th 1803
