



A draught of a tract of land called - situate on the waters of Holl-  
and Run which emptys into Susqueh<sup>a</sup>-above the Mahanoy Mountain about  
one mile and a half west of the old Shamoken road including a piece  
of meadow ground some trees that are deadned and the foundation of  
a cabb<sup>n</sup> about nine miles from Fort Augusta in the County of Northum-  
berland containing one hundred & twelve acres and a quarter of an  
acre besides the usual allowance of 6 P cent for roads &c<sup>o</sup> surveyed the  
8<sup>th</sup> day of December 1773 for William Maglay Esq<sup>e</sup> in pursuance of a warrant  
dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December 1772
