



The above is a draught of a tract of land lying on the middle branch of Pidgeon Creek surveyed for John McPherrin Patrick McCullough John Greenlees & Henry Mc Donough June 2^d 1787 in pursuance of a warrant dated at Philadelphia Decem^r 27th 1785 called the Anvil containing three hundred & fifteen acres with the allowance of six per cent for roads &c
