



By Virtue of a warrant dated October the 18th Dom 1750 surveyed to John Bruce in right of Lodowick Moser (agreeable to the old lines) the above described tract of land containing one hundred fifteen acres & a half ~~sixty seven~~ perches & the usual allowance of 6 p^{er} cent for roads & highways situate for the most part in Springfield Township Bucks County & a small part in Lower Saucon Township Northampton County

Surveyed August 29th Dom 1785

N.B. The warrant mentions for the land to be in Philadelphia County but according to the other descriptions it must undoubtedly ^{be} the land above described
