



A Draft of two tracts of land situate in Hamilton township in the County of Northampton. One of them Originally Surveyed to Jacob Miller by Warrant dated the 2^d January 1787, containing 144 Acres & allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent, the other Surveyed to Anthony Kintz by Warrant dated the 18th October 1816, containing 203 Acres 28 perches & allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent &c^a. Divided between Anthony Kintz, Christopher Bittenbender and Conrad Hamerer the 25th October 1816. Anthony Kintz's part of the two tracts contains One hundred and fifty-nine Acres, - a quarter and the allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent &c^a.
