



Draught of Eighty seven Acres and eight perches with 6 pr. Ct. - situate in Ferma-  
 nagh Township, Mifflin County, part of 169<sup>a</sup> 112 perches. appears to have been Sur-  
 veyed 3<sup>rd</sup> of Dec<sup>r</sup>. 1768. by Virtue of an Order of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 5117, dated 29<sup>th</sup> July  
 1768 to Denman Beris. Then Cumberland County. the above part resurveyed 24<sup>th</sup>  
 Jan<sup>y</sup>. 1824.
