But for divers consid<sup>rs</sup> mention<sup>d</sup> in a Warrt from the prop<sup>rs</sup> dated ye 28<sup>th</sup> of June 1737. two hund<sup>d</sup> acres thereof was grant<sup>d</sup> ed to Andrew Moore & Returned into the Secretary's Office ye 28<sup>th</sup> of June afores<sup>d</sup>.
