Surveyed on the ~~Second~~<sup>20<sup>th</sup></sup> Day of March 1735 to ~~Edward A.~~<sup>George Scholze</sup> a Tract of land Near New comissiohoppin in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup>. Begining at a post a Corner of Jacob Fishers land thence by the Same South Fifty Degrees East Seventy Eight perches to a post in the line of Michael Zeiglers land thence by the Same North forty Degrees East one hundred and Twenty perches to a post thence by lands of Mendal Myan North fifty Degrees West one hundred and Sixty perches and by Vacant land twenty perches to a post, thence by Vacant land South Forty Degrees West one hundred and fifty Eight perches to a hichry tree, thence by Vacant land South fifty Degrees East one hundred and two perches to a post in the said Jacob Fishers line thence by the Same North forty Degrees West thirty Eight perches to ye place of Begining. Containing one hundred and Fifty Acres with Usual Allowance
