



The above described tract of Land, situate in Letterkenny Township, Franklin County, containing Ninety two acres, and twenty three perches of Land &c allowance, is part of a larger tract, which was surveyed on the 12th day of April 1786 to Robert, James & John McConnel, in pursuance of their Warrant for 300⁹ dated the 17th day of January 1785, by Matthew Henderson, Esq^r, formerly a Dept^r Surveyor, and resurveyed & divided off by Daniel Henderson, Esq^r late Dept^r Surveyor, the 3rd day of Nov^r 1801, as appears by official drafts, thereof remaining in my Office, which I have examined and I believe are correct.
