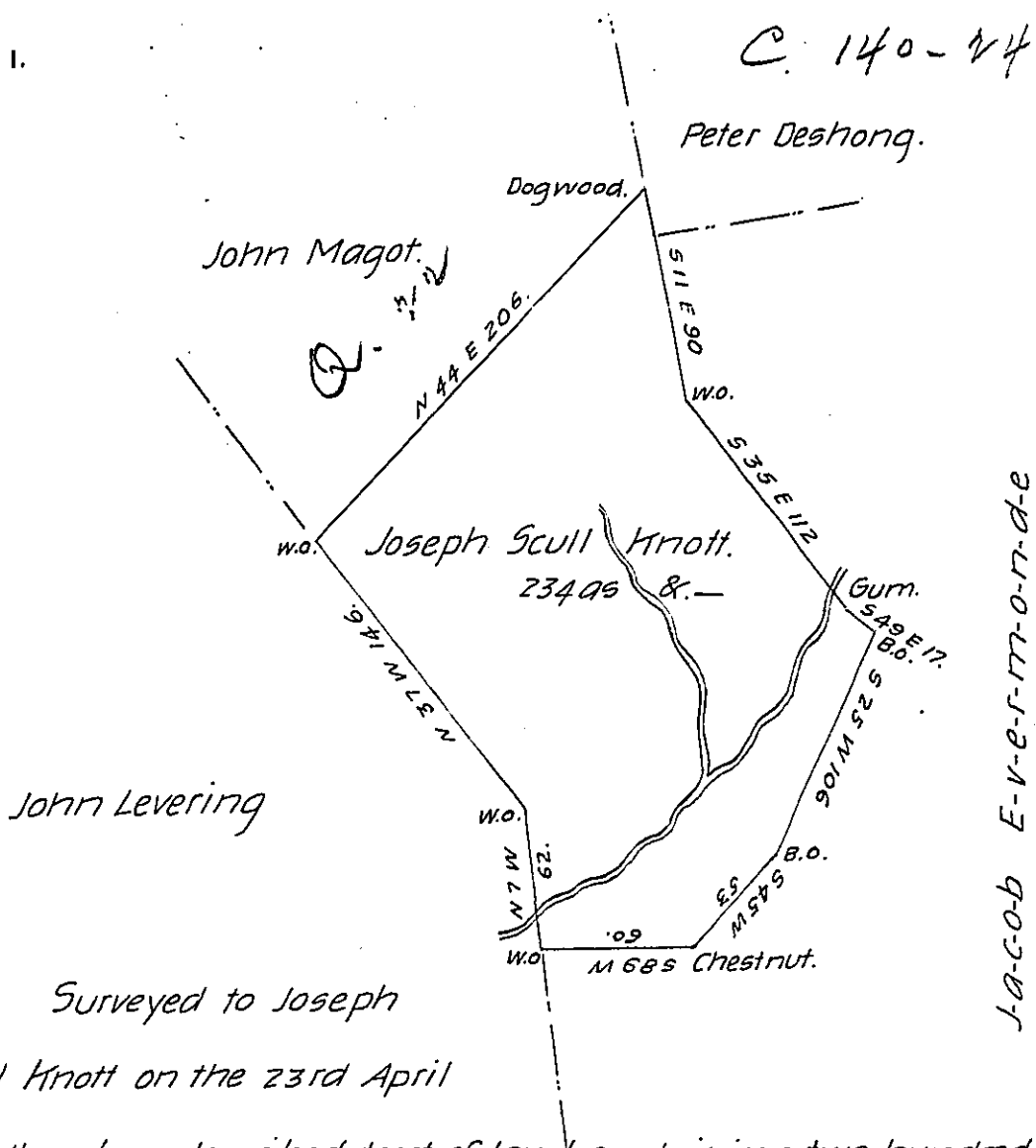

Surveyed to Joseph Scull Knott on the 23rd April 1789 the above described tract of land containing two hundred and thirty four acres and allowance of Six per cent & Situate on a Run emptying into Crooked Creek on the North Side and adjoining land Surveyed to Jacob Evermonde and John Levering in Westmorland County by Warrant of the 22nd April 1786.

N.B. The Warrant by which this Tract was Surveyed was intended for land on Crooked Creek but was Surveyed by an earlier Warrant.

In testimony that the above is a true copy of the original remaining filed in the Deputy Surveyor's office of Armstrong County, I have onto set my hand this 4th day of April 1840. For Isaiah Guthrie D.S.

N.B. The above Survey is not signed by the then Deputy Surveyor but appears to be the hand writing of Joshua Elder.

And now to wit on the 13th day of March 1840 Resurveyed the above described tract of land to Theophilus Smith containing two hundred and thirty four acres and allowance of Six per cent & Situate (in now) Plumbcreek Township Armstrong County.
