



Situate on a Branch of Sunderlands Run in Franklin township Fayette County and Surveyed the 31st day of August 1832. In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of George King for 98 acres of land dated the 10th day of March 1832.

There is about 60 acres cleared, 3 log houses, or cabbins, and families therein; also a log Barn and apple Orchard, the improvement appears as if it might be 40 years of age
