



The small Tract of Land above described is Situate adjoining the South West Corner of Faggs Mannor, Part in East Nottingham but (I think) chiefly in Oxford Township, Chester County; Survey'd the 29th of the 1st month (March) 1744. In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to the above said John Mayze, bearing date the 25th of January 1743. I thought this Survey had been return'd soon after it was made, ^{by my Father} There being a Dispute (on account thereof) subsisting between said Mayze & David Porter, which I believe was heard & determined by Governor Thomas; but Mayze tells me he has searched the Office & the Return can't be found now.
