



By virtue of a Warrant of the 28th of June A.D. 1763 was resurvey'd to  
 Walter Mc Cool December ye 9th of the same year the above described Tract of  
 Land situate in Richland Township Bucks County containing 122 Acres  
perches and allowance

N.B. Tho' the patent which Walter Mc Cool has for his other Land in the Descrip-  
 tion of it mentions from a W. Oak by a Line of mark'd trees (now of Lewis's) East  
 15 perches to a stone, and thence by a Line of mark'd Trees and Land of Sam-  
 uel Thomas North & C. I found, when on the spot, that to extend sd Thomas's  
 Line to that of Lewis's, it woud intersect it not less than 35 ps from sd W. Oak.  
 The Reason of which to discover, I ordered the chain to be carried along the  
 Line  
 123 Pole, (also mentioned in sd patent) to begin at the post by Jacob Blearn's
