



A Draught of Two Tracks of land in Reading Township in the County of York Surveyed the 8th December 1788 to Daniel Bruch The Piece Marked with the letter A. In Pursuance of Two Warrants one in the name of John Leatherman dated the 7th day of December 1751 The Other in the Name of Hermaneus Bruch Dated the 18th October 1765 Containing one Hundred and Ninety Three Acres and Three Eighths and the Usual Allowance. The Piece Marked with the letter B. In Pursuance of a Warrant to Said Daniel Bruch Dated the 19th December 1788. Containing Seven Acres and Seventy one perches and the Usual Allowance of Six Acres P Cent for Roads &c.
