Being part of a larger Tract of 82^{2/3} & 97 Perches & allowance which was Originally Surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 8th of 3rd Month 1793. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 50^{2/3} Granted to Joseph Ligget bearing date the 18th day of June Anno Domini 1792. And afterwards the above divided off from the said larger Tract. And now at the Request of the present owner Charles Diehl, I am desired to make Return of the Draught as calculated examined and Corrected the 15th day of August Anno Domini 1809.
