



By Virtue of a Warrant from The Proprietor Dated the 23rd Day of October Anno Domini 1736
 The Largest of the above Described Tracts of Land was Surveyed to John Lewis in the Township
 of Cumru and County of Lancaster Beginning at a Black Oak Thence West by Vacant Land
 92 perches to a Beech Thence North By the same 15 perches to a Black Oak &c. Containing
 Two Hundred & ^{one} Thirti^y acres Beside the Usual Allowance &c.
 The Lesser Tract By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the 17th Day of January Anno Domini
 1737 in the Township and County of foresaid Beginning at a Black Oak a Corner of the above
 mentioned Tract of Lewis's Thence East by Vacant Land 10 perches to a hickery &c. Contain-
 ing One Hundred and ^{one} forty^y acres Beside the Usual Allowance of Six Pcent. Both Surv-
 eyed ye 19th 2^{mo} 1738.
