 allowance ~~aforesaid~~ as above. Surveyed to the said Wm Love on his Warrant dated
 the 11th day of January A.D. 1772. The two above described tracts of land appears
 to have been both regularly on the 5th day of May A.D. 1772 by Thomas Lightfoot then
 D.S. a copy of said Surveys together with the field notes &c. was put into my hands
 and having examined the same, think they may be depended upon. Certified the
 7th day of July 1803.
