By virtue of a Warrant dated Dec^r: 9th 1807 Situate on the waters of Crooked Creek and adjoining lands of William Cooper Elisha Brown Jacob Stine and Isaac Franks Plum Creek Township Armstrong County - taken from his draft now in this Office which I have examined and find Correct Certified this 28th day of May 1815.
