Situate on the Waters of Wells Creek, a branch of Storey Creek, in Storey Creek Township Somerset County Including an Improvement. And Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> Day of January 1799. By Alexander McClean Esquire, then Deputy Surveyor. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of January 1798 Granted to George Lebe for 400<sup>sq</sup> As appears by his Official draught remaining in my Office. - Certified this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February 1815.
