



In pursuance of an Order of resurvey from the Board of Property dated the 17th day of January 1814, stating that a survey upon a Warrant No 94 for a thousand acres to Josiah Lockart had been made; that a survey on a Warrant to James Strawbridge interfered with it; - that Strawbridges survey had been established by the Court at Sunbury; and requiring a resurvey to exclude such part as was included by Strawbridges survey; The above described resurvey was made on the 14th and 15th of July 1814; it is situate on Cowanesque or Log Creek and the south Branch of the River Tioga, near their Confluence and that Josiah Lockarts Warrant No 94 contains now but four hundred and one acres 64 Perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads. &c.
