



A Being part of a larger tract said to contain 139 @ 78 RS & all. Surveyed April 19th 1794 by John Forsythe D.S. by warrant to John Grosscast dated Feb^y 4th 1791 divided from the residue August 3rd 1811 for the heirs of Rich^d Kitchen deceased.

B Being also part of a larger tract said to contain 53 @ & all. Surveyed April 19th 1794 by John Forsythe D.S. by warrant to George Higas dated March 31st 1789 divided from the residue August 3rd 1811 for the heirs of Richard Kitchen deceased containing fifty five perches & all. the two pieces containing together one hundred & twenty seven acres forty six perches & all.
