



Situate in Earl Township Berks County Containing Forty one acres, one hundred and sixteen perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c, twenty three acres, seventy five perches & all part of a larger tract of forty four acres & three quarters & all surveyed to Peter Hall in pursuance of a warrant dated the 4th of July 1750. Eighteen acres & forty one perches & allowance part of a larger tract of one hundred ten acres & an half surveyed to Henry Diener in pursuance of a warrant dated the 12th October 1770. Resurveyed & divided for John Wesner.
