



A Draught of Two Tracts of Land whereof the first is Situated in Upper Solford Township—Containing Thirty four acres and 49 perches of Land and the usual allowance. And the Second is Situated in Marlborough Township and Contains Thirty four acres and 46 perches of Land and the usual allowance for roads. Both Tracts Lying in the County of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania and were Surveyed for Daniel Heester By virtue of a Warrant granted to him by the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries dated on the 23^d May Anno—1750. Surveyed by Order of the Surveyor General on the 9^d October Anno—1765. P—David Shultze.
