



The above described tract of sixty acres and forty six perches of Land and allowance is part of a larger tract of one hundred and seventy seven acres, one hundred & twenty five perches & allowance situate in Washington (formerly Antrim) Township, Franklin County (formerly Cumberland) which was surveyed to Jacob Wertz by John Armstrong Esq^r formerly Deputy Surveyor the 16th day of March 1765, in pursuance of two Warrants from the Honble Proprietaries, one whereof granted to Dart^r Hendricks bearing Date the 1st of Oct^r 1754, the other granted to Jacob Wertz dated the 4th day of May 1763. Resurveyed and divided off the 20th day of August 1806, by To Samuel Cochran Esq^r Surveyor Gen^r of Pennsylvania Tho. Kirby D.S. IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this third day of November 1905.
