



The above described tract of sixty acres and forty six perches of Land and allowance is part of a larger tract of one hundred and seventy seven acres, one hundred & twenty five perches & allowance situate in Washington (formerly Antrim) Township, Franklin County (formerly Cumberland) which was surveyed in one survey to Jacob Wertz by John Armstrong Esq^r formerly Deputy Surveyor, the 16th day of March 1765, in pursuance of two Warrants from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries; one ^{was} whereof granted to Dan^l Hendricks bearing Date the 1st of Oct^r 1754, the Other granted to Jacob Wertz dated the 4th day of May 1763.
